As a foster parent you will be required to keep your foster dog(s) on a leash or enclosed (within a fence adequate for the animal or in your home) at all times. Foster cats must be kept indoors at all times. By Initialing below, you acknowledge that you will abide by these provisions. Initial: _____

As a foster parent, you may have an animal in your care for a short period of time (1 week) or an extended period of time (as many as 3 months or more). This will frequently be determined when you receive an animal to be fostered. However, this amount of time is subject to change depending on circumstances at the shelter. If you know that you will be on vacation during the period of time you are being asked to foster, you are obliged to inform the Animal Control Center as such. This will allow us to find the most suitable temporary accommodations for your foster animal(s).

All new foster parents must attend a foster orientation. You will be contacted in regards to the date, time, and location of this orientation. Additionally, while you are caring for a foster animal, we may call you from time to time to check on the animals' progress and address any concerns you may have.

All veterinary care is to be administered by the Animal Control Center veterinarian. A contract number will be supplied to you at the time of foster. Any outside veterinary care that you incur will be at your expense. Heartworm prevention will be supplied.

As a foster parent, we want you to know that it is occasionally necessary to euthanize animals that have been in foster care. Although this is an option of last resort, it does occur for numerous reasons.

By signing this form, I agree to the above statements and certify that the answers given are true. I further hold the City Parish Government and the Animal Control Center harmless from any and all damages that may arise from my being a foster care participant.
